Overview

 HSRC/SAHARA is collaborating with UCSF on the SAMHMS project

• Full title: The South Africa Men's Health Monitoring Study (SAMHMS): Protocol for an Integrated Biological Behavioral Survey (IBBS) with Population Size Estimation using Respondent Driven Sampling (RDS) among men who have sex with men (MSM)





Project Objectives

- To measure HIV prevalence & incidence and associated risk behaviors among MSM in the select sites
- > To estimate the pop size and distribution of MSM in SA
- ➤ To identify determinants of access and utilization of health & social welfare programs among MSM in SA
- To enhance local capacity to conduct IBBS, mapping & size estimation among MSM





Proposed procedures include:

- Administering a risk behavior questionnaire.
- HIV/STI risk assessment and disclosure counseling.
- Rapid HIV testing with confirmatory testing (for +)
- Referral of persons testing HIV+ to collaborating clinics for care and support.
- QA testing for HIV using DBS at the SA NICD.
- HIV testing samples, & incidence HIV+ samples, for surveillance purposes at the SA NICD.
- storage of DBS for future incidence testing (testing for HIV incidence/new infections within the study sample).





Study Sites/locations

The study proposes five sites for conducting study

- Mafikeng (NorthWest province)
- Polokwane (Limpopo province)
- Bloemfontein (Free State province)
- Kimberly (Northern Cape province)
- Port Elizabeth (Eastern Cape province)

*Mpumalanga (TBD)





Target Population (n=500)

Eligibility Criteria

- Biological Male
- Age ≥ 16 years
- Had anal/oral sex with men in the past 6m
- In possession of a valid referral coupon
- Reside, work, or socialize in study area for ≥ 6m

Exclusion criteria:

- Previous participation in the survey at any of the study sites
- Inability to provide written informed consent (including persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs)






Discussion points
