- A proposal on possible structure of extended sets:

Summary of decisions from 7th meeting - Dublin, Sept 2007

- Purpose equalisation of opportunities + prevalence
- Three areas of extensions
 - 1) expand on the number of domains (emotional functioning, cognition, pain and fatigue)
 - 2) adding supplementary items and revisit some decisions on functioning items (whether 1 or two or more Qs); issues of onset, etc.
 - 3) environmental issues within domains and separately
- look at different ways to address participation
- Coordination to other groups working on similar activities.

Development along two axes

- The Short Set focuses on 6 basic action domains: seeing, hearing, walking, cognition, self care and communication
- There is a need to:
 - expand upon the set of basic domains
 - include more complex activity domains
 - expand upon the number of questions per domain
 - use of assistive devices
 - levels of functioning with assistance
 - age at onset, cause, duration
 - Address environmental factors

 - Work
 - School
 - Household activities
 - Shopping
 - Social activities
 - Religious activities

Question Topic/Type: The Rows

- Capacity: Short set single questions
- Capacity: Extended set Multiple questions
- Domain specific:
 - Use of Assistive Devices Micro Environment
 - Performance: Functioning with Assistance
 - Experience of fatigue / pain
 - Age at onset, Cause, Duration, Impact
 - Meso-Environment: beyond the person (may also be non domain specific)
- Macro-Environment: societal including laws, regulations, attitudes

Question topic/type	Mobility					
Short set	Do you have difficulty walking or climbing steps?					
Extended set	How difficult is it for you to walk ¼ mile or ½ km? How difficult is it for you to climb a flight of stairs?					
Micro- Environment	Do you use an ambulatory aid, such as a cane, walker or wheelchair?					
Functioning with Assistance	How difficult is it for you to walk ¼ mile or ½ km? How difficult is it for you to climb a flight of stairs?					
Experience of Pain or Fatigue	Do you experience any pain or fatigue when you walk a ¼ mile or climb a flight of stairs?					
Age at onset	How old were you when you first started having difficulty walking or climbing steps?					
Cause	What condition or health problem is the reason for you difficulty walking and/or climbing steps?					
Duration	How long have you had your current level of difficulty walking and/or climbing steps?					
Impact	How does your difficulty affect your ability to work, attend school, etc?					
Meso- Environment	Is the availability/accessibility of transportation a problem for you?					
Macro- Environment	How often have government programs and policies made it difficult for you to do what you want or need to do?
