





- "I get two thousand bucks a month, I can put that money in my one pocket, it's little and the banks charge for services even for little cash, AINT WORTH IT."





Because parents feel uncomfortable about talking to their kids about sex, kids tend to refrain from talking to them and asking them necessary questions.











#### What is the main reason learners dropout at school?





# Poverty is at the heart of the challenge

- Youth challenges reflect national challenges & national policy choices (e.g., macro-economic
- Participation is compromised by lack of protection
- Need incentives to stay in school, protect from pregnancy & HIV, not get involved in violence
- Discounting consequences (finding a job, drop-out, pregnancy)
- Need hope for the future & opportunities
