
Proportion of Race Groups in Treatment Centre






Race by Primary Substance of Abuse





Mean Age by Primary Substance




Age of Onset of Alcohol Dependence

- greater alcohol dependence (15% before age Alcohol use at an early age is associated with
- adults associated with unintentional injuries, Early onset of drinking among adolescents/ car accidents, physical fights, unplanned and unprotected sex
- A quarter of alcohol dependent adults have sought help at some point
- dependence took longer to seek help. Those with an earlier onset of alcohol

Age of Onset of Alcohol Dependence

- 31% who became dependent before age 18 took 10 years or more after onset of 30 or older dependence to seek treatment compared to 10% of those who became dependent at age
- Persons dependent at younger ages experience multiple episodes of dependence (chronic relapse), of longer duration and more alcohol dependence symptoms
- Screening and brief motivational counseling and university students can reduce risky drinking among adolescents

Percent who waited 10 years+ for treatment by age at first alcohol dependence


