Requirements & principles

- Must cover the Strategic Plan for S. Strategic Plan African Agriculture as well as the DoA's
- Must be consistent with Treasury's "Framework"
- System must be logical, complete and feasible

Adapting Treasury's "Framework"

- Hierarchy of performance 'monitoring concepts':
- Inputs → Activities → Outputs → Outcomes → Impacts
- Should identify indicators for each....
- Problem: too much detail and too complex
- Suggested simplification:
- Activities/Outputs → Outcomes → Impacts
- Clarify distinction bt 'outcomes' and 'impacts' □ 'Outcomes' – results for specific beneficiaries
- □ 'Impacts' results for broader target group(s)
- But note: outcomes and impacts not related 1-to-1



- [A] Administrative data, e.g. from DoA itself
- [S] Secondary data, e.g. from an existing Stats SA data series
- [R] requires specialised Research or data gathering
